Members of the AFEO are Engineering Institutions and Unions of countries in ASEAN. The objectives of AFEO are the promotion of goodwill, understanding, cooperation and exchange of ideas and experiences in the fields of education, science, engineering, technology, environment, human resource, training and registration of professional engineers.

The Conference of the ASEAN Federation of Engineering Organizations (CAFEO) has been held annually since 1982 by 10 ASEAN member countries, namely, Brunei, Indonesia, Malaysia, Singapore, Philippines, Thailand, Cambodia, Vietnam, Laos and Myanmar. The CAFEO has also attracted the participation of engineering organizations of the USA, Japan, Korea, Australia, China, India, Germany and the UK, the World Federation of Engineering Organizations (WFEO) and ASEAN Academy of Engineering and Technology (AAET).
